

Grant Application Information

The Lexington Seminar offers grants of \$20,000 to each of the five institutions participating in the 2007 Seminar.

Application Form (4-6 single-spaced pages)

Applications should include the following items:

1. State the issue in teaching and learning that you are addressing and the nature of the educational project that you have designed in response to this issue.
2. List your goals for the project.
3. Describe the activities you will undertake, including a timetable for implementation.
4. Describe how you will evaluate your project.
5. State who will be responsible for leading the project and their qualifications for this responsibility.
6. State how you intend to continue the goals of the project after the grant period.
7. Include a budget for the grant and indicate any institutional funds and other resources to be used in the project.
